

Gas inspection in practice

To prepare for our visit

Your request can only be carried out by Certinergie for a natural gas installation (previously called 'mains gas') and of which the power of the devices does not exceed more than 70 kW per premise. If your installation fulfils these conditions, Certinergie will not be able to carry out the inspection and a flat rate of €96.80 (VAT included) will be invoiced for the cancellation of the meeting.

- The meter and the devices using gas should be installed, without which we cannot carry out the inspection. The meter does not necessarily have to be installed for Flanders (Fluvius/Eandis), the region operated by ORES and Brussels (Sibelga).
- If required (pipes installed after 2014), the **isometric diagram** of the installation should be ready, **signed by the installer**. This is the 3-D diagram of the pipes, valves and principal elements of the installation. These are also included: the types of pipes, their diameter, their length, the devices with their power. If this diagram has not been carried out and you would like our assistance to carry it out, please contact us as soon as possible so that we can adjust your request. You will be invoiced with a surcharge of €30 (including VAT). Without adjusting the request, the outcome of the inspection will be non-compliant.
- Instruction manuals and installation manuals of gas-consuming devices.
- A **Tee fitting** must be placed close to the meter (see the standard for the different possible configurations); it will be used to carry out the system leakage test during an inspection to activate the meter, without which we cannot carry out the inspection. This has been mandatory since **2004**. For older installations, and those featuring a meter with numbers after the comma, the Tee is not mandatory.
- The previous inspection reports if your installation has already been inspected.
- The presence of a person on site to give us access to the entire installation, ideally the installer.

In the case of cancellation within the 24 business hours preceding the day of the meeting (or within 48 business hours if the cancellation falls on the day before a bank holiday or within 72 business hours if the cancellation falls on a weekend), you will be billed up to €96.80 (tax included) for the booked inspection.
