

Tank inspection in practice

To prepare for our visit

To carry out the tank inspection, we need:

- Access to an accessible and working plug socket (min. 16A). In the absence of which, the inspection will be terminated. We will not be able to issue a certificate, but a flat rate of €150 (tax included) will be invoiced for a cancellation at your fault.
- Access to the boiler.
- For inaccessible tanks, an effective **level** of liquid fuel that is less than **80% of the tank's capacity** to be able to carry out the test. If it is too high, the inspection will be terminated. No certificate will be able to be issued, but a flat rate of €150 (tax included) will be invoiced for a cancellation at your fault.
- For more than 6000 l tanks, the class 3 declaration on the day of our visit. This being a legal obligation. In the absence of which, the inspection will be invoiced in its entirety and the tank will be declared non-compliant. You will find below the link that allows you to download the said class 3 declaration form to send to your municipality.

Furthermore, we will need **where possible** the following items:

- The name and/or brand of the manufacturer.
- The number and year of manufacture.
- The capacity in litres.
- The water resistance certificate from the tank factory.
- The nature and type of tank.
- The tank's certificate of compliance.
- The tank's installation date.
- The certificate attesting the installation of the tank and its connection in accordance with the current requirements issued by a qualified expert.
- The routine water resistance certificate of the entire installation issued by an approved engineer.
- The data sheet for the materials used to waterproof the spill containment system.

Certinergie cannot be held responsible for defusing of the suction pipe after a depression test has been carried out, in accordance with the current regulation.

In the case of cancellation within the 24 business hours preceding the day of the meeting (or within 48 business hours if the cancellation falls on the day before a bank holiday or within 72 business hours if the cancellation falls on a weekend), you will be billed up to €96.80 (tax included) for the booked inspection.
